Hunting Section Descriptions

Property lines

The yellow lines outlining the entire property are fairly easy to follow. In the woods on the entire north side we are outlined with the mud creek. On the south the open field and fencing marks the line. On the west the property is posted and for the most part when you are in the bottom if you go west and go up hill you are going off the property. Please respect our neighbors and stay off of any property you don't have written permission to be on. Members that disrespect the property lines will lose their good standing status and future permission to hunt and possibility membership to the fish and game. Not to mention possible broken laws of trespassing.

Section A,

This is the pines and pond area from the 100 yard shooting bench on the west to the tip of the property to the east and about ½ ways across the pond and grassy area.

1st Section "No Hunting"

This first no hunting section is from the 100 yard shooting bench on the east to about 200 yards into the woods on the west. You will notice signs warning that you are entering behind the shooting range at the west of the no hunting section. The creek marks the line protecting the buildings on the east.

Section B,

This is a top section going from the no hunting on the south into the bottom and eventually to the creek on the north and another creek on the east toward the buildings.

Section C.

This is the furthest west section along the south side. As you go north this section goes to the edge of the ravine.

Section D.

This is in the bottom from the hillside on the south to the creek on the north.

Section E.

This section is where the bottom begins to narrow. As you move north you will be flanked on the east by the creek and the west by the neighboring property owner's hill top. You will come to signs at the north line that say keep out. This is the 2nd no hunting section.

2nd Section "No Hunting"

This section is off limits to hunting, deer pushing and shooting in general. The personal property and homes close to this section is one reason no shooting can be done here. Also we are trying to have a wildlife sanctuary to let animals feel safe and reproduce on the property. By giving a section for wildlife... all hunting will be better in the future for all.
